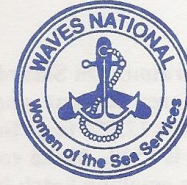




## PLAN OF THE YEAR - 2011

Our new port will be the Sheraton Safari Hotel and Suites, 1225 South Apopka-Vineland Road, Lake Buena Vista, Florida. We will get underway Thursday, September 22<sup>nd</sup>, to Sunday, September 25th, 2011. This is a celebration of Sea Service Women and a fun time to share. The convention will be headed by Sharon Breece, President of the ANWNA, and B. J. McGuire, State Director, Region XII, WAVES National.

Barbara J. McGuire, Region XII/Florida State Director, WAVES National, would like to extend a welcome to all women who have served in the military to Florida's State Conference. We are meeting again with our fantastic sister organization, All Navy Women's National Alliance. We look forward to meeting all and sharing some sea stories. We have some interesting sessions planned. I look forward to seeing everyone.

Our WAVES National meeting will be Friday, September 23<sup>rd</sup> from 1300 to 1630 (with snacks). Please come join us for our semi-annual meeting and bring your ideas and requests for this important meeting.

**3. HOTEL RESERVATIONS:**

**Make your reservations directly with the Sheraton Safari Hotel. If you are NOT from the Orlando area, call 1-800-423-3297 (make sure you mention that you are with either the All Navy Women's National Alliance or WAVES National). If you are from the Orlando area, call 407-239-0444. We suggest you call Monday – Friday (0900 to 1600) where it goes directly to hotel reservations at**

the Sheraton. On Saturday and Sunday and after hours, calls go to an operator in another state. Rooms are: Regular and Double Occupancy: \$69 per night plus 12.5% tax. Suites are \$99 per night plus 12.5% tax. Suites include two queen-sized beds and a pull-out bed from the sofa. Check-in time is 1500. Make your reservations by August 22nd. Handicap rooms are available. The hotel is a non-smoking hotel; however, if you are a smoker, when you make your reservation inform them so you can be assigned to a room with a balcony. If you are diabetic, the hotel will furnish a refrigerator for free. The hotel has some rooms with large chairs to sleep in, but you must reserve by Wednesday, August 22<sup>nd</sup>. The hotel does allow pets but a deposit is required. Transportation to all local Disney entertainment complexes is available at the front door of the hotel with frequent stops.
